

## Councillor Report

### 1. Attendance, Availability and Health

I continued to carry out my Cornwall Council duties throughout January and early February, including formal committees, briefings, training, and casework. I have been on sick leave for approximately the last week due to a chest infection and was unable to attend some community meetings during that period, including a Community Chest meeting. This was communicated at the time.

### 2. Engagement with Treverbyn Parish Council

I have maintained written engagement with Treverbyn Parish Council and the Clerk regarding local issues and correspondence. I have responded formally to correspondence from the Parish Council regarding a request for a meeting following my previous councillor report, setting out my position and confirming my willingness to continue engagement in writing or via the Clerk where appropriate.

### 3. Community and Local Casework

Community Chest: I approved a £250 Community Chest grant for Treverbyn Community Trust, confirming that I have no personal interests in the organisation.

Bins / waste issues: I was copied into correspondence between Cornwall Council and Treverbyn Parish Council regarding overflowing bins at Century Close, with confirmation that the matter was being followed up and resolved.

### 4. Cornwall Council Committees, Meetings and Training

During the reporting period I attended or was scheduled to attend the following: Miscellaneous Licensing Committee sittings; Central Sub Area Planning Committee; China Clay Area & Luxulyan Community Area Partnership meeting; Storm Goretti Member Focus feedback session; member development and training sessions; and briefings and group meetings relating to planning, housing, transport, and council governance.

### 5. Planning Matters

I attended Treverbyn Parish Planning and supported local residents and the Parish Planning Committee in relation to a proposed development in Penwithick. I also continued to engage with wider planning matters affecting the area, including pre-application discussions, review of weekly planning lists, and attendance at formal planning committee meetings where applicable.

## **6. Council-Wide Issues and Policy Work**

I have been involved in discussions and correspondence relating to accessibility and reasonable adjustments to enable me to carry out my councillor role; council governance, standards, and member conduct matters; and preparation of questions for Full Council and engagement with group colleagues on policy issues.

## **7. Forward Look**

I expect to resume normal duties following my recent illness. I will continue to engage with Treverbyn Parish Council via the Clerk on parish matters and will continue to attend Cornwall Council committees, CAP meetings, and planning forums as scheduled.
